Hello MARTA members. My name is Tracy Danberry, and I have been working in Developmental and Reproductive Toxicology since 1987. I started my career at Rohm and Haas, and was a Principal Investigator in the Teratology department for 15 years. During that time I was involved with two-generation studies, Seg I and Seg II studies, as well as numerous general tox studies.

When they sold the Agriculture business, I transitioned to Bristol-Myers Squibb as a Reproductive Toxicology Scientist, where I not only worked on Seg II studies, but also was able to work on developing and trouble-shooting the rat whole embryo culture and zebrafish embryo culture assays in order to allow in-house screening and investigative work.

After 6 years there, I went to Huntingdon Life Sciences (now Envigo) as a member of Training and Compliance, which allowed me to utilize my general tox experience along with the fetal pathology. There I was able to design and implement fetal pathology training for new and existing staff, validate the new CASA system, as well as round out my general tox experience with a very broad exposure to multiple study designs. While at HLS I was able to capitalize on my fetal pathology experience and earn an Assessor title in the International Registry of Fetal Morphologists.

After 6 years at HLS, it was clear to me that I was truly passionate about DART, and when the opportunity presented itself I jumped on it, and was lucky enough to obtain another position at BMS as a Reproductive Toxicology Scientist. Now back 'home', I have also monitored studies at other laboratories and have Study Directed some investigative and range-finding DART studies.
